We are very excited to announce the official launch of the Kinderlime Online Tuition management Service for Dolphin Center beginning the week of August 28th! This service offers the convenience of automatic withdrawal of your tuition through credit card payments or a checking account.*

**Please note, there will be a \$1.95 charge per billing cycle using a checking account and a \$1.95 plus 2.5% charge when using a credit card.*

There are two ways for parents to access their accounts. One is the Parent app on the apps stores for mobile devices. The other is through the website: www.kinderlime.com.

Access through the Kinderlime Parent App



Kinderlime has parent apps for online payments and viewing communication from the school. The school is going to send parent app registration codes in the next few days. You can download the Kinderlime Parent app from either the Android or the iOS apps store and register by entering your unique registration code (if you haven't done so last year.) Once you have access through the parent app, you can setup your payment account, in order to pay through the app.

Setting up your payment information

Once you create a login, Kinderlime will send you a verification email. Click on the verification link to verify your email after which, you will be able to login.

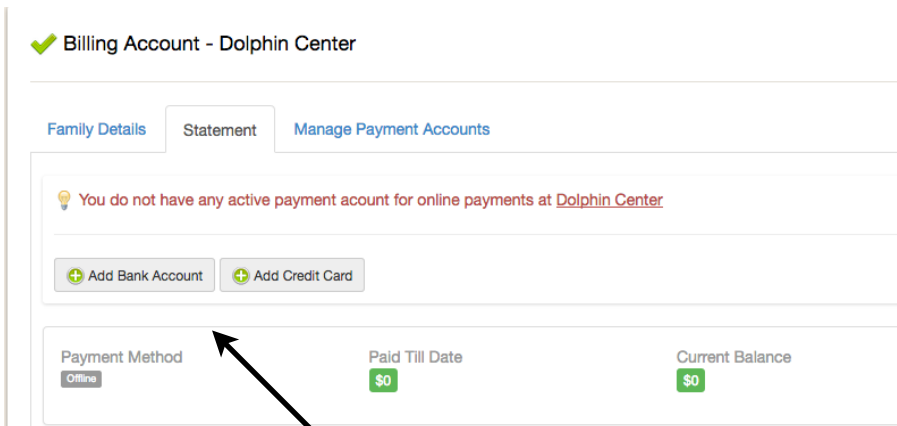
After logging in to your Kinderlime Parent Account, you can add your Credit Card or Bank Account for online payments to school.

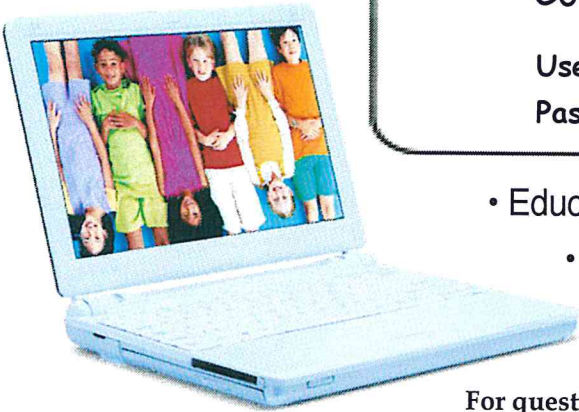

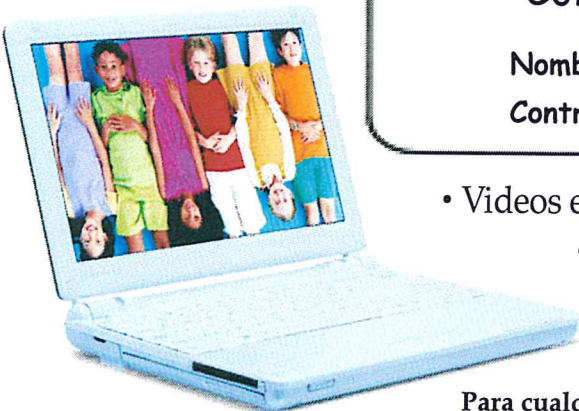
