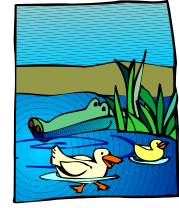

MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT/PRINCIPAL:

The STAR (Standardized Testing and Reporting) testing window for Cold Spring School District will run from April 22 - May 17, with most teachers testing for a few days in the middle of that window (early May). Every second through eleventh grader in California is assessed on their mastery of grade level skills in the core subject areas. The results of these assessments are received during the summer and sent home to parents.

It is important that students are not absent from school on testing days, are well rested and have had a nutritious breakfast. If you are uncertain when your child will be tested during the testing window, please contact your child's teacher so that he/she can show up rested and well-prepared!
