Battle of the Books Grades 4-6

This past week students in Grades 4-6 were introduced to the Battle of the Books program. This event is sponsored by the County Schools and will take place on April 30, 2014. We introduce the program this early in the school year so that students can have plenty of time to read as many of the 30 books on the Battle of the Books reading list. To represent Cold Spring at the Battle, students must read at least 15 of the books, attend lunch discussion meetings starting in January, and pass a written test made of sample questions from the Battle. We are allowed to take 5 students.

The event is held at the County Schools Auditorium and at the event our students from Cold Spring are placed on teams with students from schools around Santa Barbara County. It's a great way for our students to meet new people who share a love for reading.

We have all 30 books available in our Library for checkout and usually the Montecito Library has them as well.

The Hike for Haiti will be on Saturday, October 19th, beginning at 9 am. This event is aimed at raising funds to build a kitchen at an elementary school, run by local non-profit Destined for Grace, in Mirebalais, Haiti.

Destined for Grace is an organization whose goal is to aid the children of Haiti and provide them with love, hope and faith. Many children in Haiti do not attend school because of the extreme level of poverty in their country. Destined for Grace acknowledges the importance of education in the development of a child and has made it their mission to provide a safe environment for children to learn. Destined for Grace opened its school in 2011 and educates 180 students in Haiti. Each student receives one hot meal each day and in order to continue doing so, we must rebuild a kitchen that is better equipped to cook for 180 students.

The event will include a 2 mile walk (not a hike) beginning at Lower Manning Park. Registration begins at 8:30 am at the tables at Lower Manning Park across from the Montecito YMCA.
